As such, we are committed to establishing relationships, processes and procedures to reduce the risk of using/testing counterfeit parts in our service provision. To this end, our objectives are to:

- Govern the detection, prevention, removal or mitigation of counterfeit, fraudulent or suspect parts from the supply chain.
- Ensure counterfeit/suspect material is appropriately reported to the manager/customer.
- Monitor and, where appropriate, take action related to industry alerts, or other guidance on suspect parts, as well as participate in industry committees striving to reduce the use to counterfeit parts throughout our industry.
- Continually improve purchasing processes aimed at reducing the risk of procuring counterfeit parts.
- Constantly challenge our external supply chain in to meet the same standard as our internal supply chain in accordance with Defence Standard 05-135.

We believe that by actively managing the risk of counterfeit parts, consumables or records from entering our service provision, we will live up to our brand promise of being 'A higher level of reliability'.
